

REGISTER AND PRIVACY STATEMENT

This is the Personal Data Act (Sections 10 and 24) and the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) Registry and Privacy Statement of Härmälän Isäntä. Prepared on May 21, 2018.

1. The register holder

3. Name of the register

Härmälän Isäntä, customer register
The register also covers websites operated by the register holder.

4. Legal basis and purpose of the processing of personal data

The legal basis for the processing of personal data under the EU General Data Protection Regulation is

- consent of the person (documented, voluntary, identified, informed and unambiguous)
- agreement to which the data subject is a party (reservation of a room)

The purpose of the processing of personal data is communication with customers, maintenance of the customer relationship, marketing, and information related to room reservations. The data is not used for automated decision making or profiling.

5. Information content of the register

The information stored in the register includes: person's name, company/organization, contact phone number, e-mail address, website addresses, IP address of the network connection, IDs/profiles on social media services, information about ordered services and their changes, billing information, other information related to the customer relationship or service orders.

6. Sources of information

The information stored in the register is obtained from the customer e.g. in connection with making a room reservation, messages sent via web forms, e-mail, telephone, via social media services, contracts, customer meetings and other situations in which the customer discloses his information, as well as various competitions and customer benefits in which the customer participates.

7. Transfers of data and transfers of data outside the EU or the EEA

The information is not regularly disclosed to other parties. The information may be published to the extent agreed with the customer. Data may also be transferred by the controller outside the EU or the EEA. At present, all data is stored within the EU.

8. Registry Security Principles

The register shall be handled with appropriate care and the data processed by the information systems shall be adequately protected. Registry information is stored on Internet servers, and the physical and digital security of their hardware is adequately taken care of. The controller shall ensure that the data stored, as well as the access rights to the servers and other information critical to the security of personal data, are treated confidentially and only by the employees whose job entails accessing the information.

9. Right of inspection and right to request correction of information

Every person in the register has the right to check the information stored in the register and to request the correction of any incorrect information or the completion of incomplete information. If a person wishes to check the data stored about them or to request a correction, the request must be sent in writing to the register holder. If necessary, the controller may ask the applicant to prove their identity. The controller will respond to the customer within the timeframe set out in the EU Data Protection Regulation.

10. Other rights related to the processing of personal data

A person in the register has the right to request the removal of their personal data from the register ("right to be forgotten"). Data subjects also have other rights under the EU's general data protection regulation, such as restrictions on the processing of personal data in certain situations. Requests must be sent in writing to the register holder. If necessary, the register holder may ask the applicant to prove their identity. The controller will respond to the customer within the timeframe set out in the EU Data Protection Regulation.
